



Job Openings: Enrolled Nurses x2

#Keready's mission is to provide accessible and affordable mobile health services to the youth in South Africa whilst running a movement that speaks frankly about health issues facing young people. Mobile outreach services proved effective during Covid-19 with over a million people reached with vaccinations in informal settlements and rural areas. The Keready campaign was likewise effective in encouraging many young people to get vaccinated. By providing 46 mobile health clinics for outreach, this model will now be used to reach other young people and extend the package of primary health services available to them.

This project is made possible through a grant to the Department of Health from the Federal Republic of Germany. DGMT, a South African foundation, is the project implementer, working with the provincial departments of Health in Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal, Western Cape and Eastern Cape.

DGMT would like to recruit individuals who are passionate about extending health care to underserved communities, focused on young people.

The Enrolled Nurses will work in the allocated district in our mobile clinic, under the supervision of the Professional Nurse. The mobile clinic team works to support integrated health services in the Province.

Minimum Requirements

- Relevant Nursing Qualification
- Current registration with SANC as Enrolled Nurse
- At least two years' work experience as an Enrolled Nurse
- Ability to communicate in English is required and any other additional language is preferable

Additional qualification will be an added advantage:

- Has experience doing Vaccinations

Prior experience working on public health campaigns, including SBCC and RCCE, and vaccine demand creation would be an advantage.

Responsibilities:

Clinical:

- Basic screening: TB, HIV, Hypertension, Diabetes, Mental health, pregnancy etc.
- Health talks and health promotion
- Give support to the Keready mobilisers
- Vitals checking: Temperature, BP, Pulse, weight, MUAC
- Expanded programme on immunization: Administration of vaccine, Vitamin A, Deworming etc.
- Growth monitoring and Family MUAC project working with the Community Health Workers
- Investigations: Sputum collection
- Defaulter tracing for TB, HIV
- Duties as designated by Professional nurse in line with scope of practice

Community engagement and demand generation:

- Executing demand creation activities on site and off site to build a positive image for the programme
- This includes the facilitation of a comprehensive health promotion program targeting patrons to the mobile clinic unit
- This also includes engagements with local communities and other local stakeholders to inform service gaps, barriers to vaccination and other primary healthcare service access i.e. location of sites and community concerns and locally prevalent vaccine disinformation and misinformation
- Collaborate with other team members to mobilize for demand creation to support site and provincial targets

Effective self-management and performance ownership

- Take ownership and accountability for tasks and demonstrates effective self-management.
- Follow through to ensure that quality and productivity standards of own work are consistently and accurately maintained.
- Maintain a professional positive attitude and respond openly to feedback.
- Drive your own career development by participating in ongoing training and development.
- Quarterly performance evaluation will be implemented.

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Additional: The incumbent needs to be willing to support beyond the responsibilities highlighted above.

- The ENs will be based in a mobile clinic and rove around the community within the district. Must be willing to work in the community.
- Preference will be given to qualified and suitably experienced candidates from the area.
